Yr 4 Residential trip to Carroty Wood Tonbridge 6 - 8 March 2019

In Year4 the children will have the opportunity to participate on a residential trip to Carroty Wood. Tonbridge 6-8 March 2019.

Carroty Wood is enclosed in 58 acres of mature woodland with plenty of natural habitat and wildlife for groups to enjoy, and a perfect location for the children to experience new adventures and explore the outdoors in a safe environment. The children will be taking part in instructor led activities and there is also the opportunity to swim in the indoor heated pool.

In order to give you as much information about the trip we will be holding a meeting in Mr Andrews Classroom on Monday 11 June at 4.15pm. Mr Andrews, who led the trip last year, will address the meeting which will give you an opportunity to find out more about the activities involved, the accommodation arrangements of the centre and to ask any questions or concerns you may have. We are aware, that for some children this may be the first time they will have been away from home without family members and naturally will feel apprehensive.

We do appreciate that not all parents will be able to attend and therefore, suggest you view the centre's website <https://rockuk.org/centres/carroty-wood> to look at what Carroty Wood has to offer.

As we have secured our trip to Carroty Wood with a holding deposit we will ask for your commitment to this trip in the first week back of the Autumn term. The cost of this trip will be approximately £160.00.

If you wish your child to attend payment for this trip will be added to your Spring term invoice issued at the end of the Autumn term.
