**Year 5 trip to Margate - Monday 3 June 2019**

An outing has been organised on Monday 3 June, for the children in Year 5 to visit Margate as part of this term's Geography curriculum. A good deal of project work will be attached to this field trip, which is always useful should it be required to support evidence of 'standard of work' in pursuit of an appeal for the Kent Test. It is therefore recommended that a good deal of effort and commitment is essential for this project.

Whilst at Margate the children will visit the Margate Museum and Tudor House, the town centre and the old town and harbour to look at the regeneration of Margate as a seaside town. The children will have a fish and chip lunch, and an ice cream.

The children will leave school at 9.00am and return at approximately 3.45pm. Children should wear their school uniform, including hats/caps, bring a small backpack, a clipboard, a full reusable water bottle and raincoat to cover all eventualities! Spending money is not permitted. The cost of this trip will be **£20.00** which covers the transport, museum entry, a fish and chip lunch and an ice cream.
