

TERM-TIME ONLY:

NURSERY FEES & CHARGES PER TERM FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/22

Registration: Initial registration is by completion of a Registration Form and payment of a non-returnable fee of £50.

Entry Deposit: An entry deposit of £500 is payable on Acceptance of an Offer. £250.00 is refundable upon the child's entry into Reception Class, and the remaining £250.00 is refundable on payment of the final invoice when the child leaves the main school. The deposit is not refundable if the child does not continue into the main school.

Fees are reduced by 10% for a second child and by 15% for a third child in a family during the time when two or more are attending the school/Nursery. Reductions for a fourth child are decided following discussion with the Headmaster.
