### **Year 2 Trip to Canterbury Cathedral - Wednesday 8 December 2021**

As part of this term's RE and Geography curriculums a trip has been arranged for Year 2 to visit Canterbury Cathedral on Wednesday 8 December 2021. The main focus of the visit is to find out about St Thomas a Becket and to understand why Canterbury Cathedral is a World Heritage Site. They will also learn about St Nicholas who helped the poor by secretly giving gold coins away.

The children will have a guided tour of the Cathedral, take part in a Costume Trail and spend some time in the Activity Room.

The children will travel by private coach, accompanied by 4 members of staff, leaving school at 9.15am and returning at approximately 3.00pm. A packed lunch will be provided by the school but the children will also need to bring a full reusable water bottle. The children will also need to wear their full school uniform, including caps/hats, and take their St Faith's shower proof coat in case of rain.

The cost of the trip will be £25.00 which covers the cost of the coach, the Costume Trail and activity session in the Cathedral and a Canterbury Cathedral goody bag (a bag which contains items from the Cathedral Gift shop). The cost of this trip will be added to your Spring term invoice issued at the end of the Autumn term.
