**Year 4 Residential Trip to Carroty Wood, Tonbridge - Wednesday 22 - Friday 24 February 2023**

Further to our meeting last term, regarding the Year 4 Residential Trip to Carroty Wood, Tonbridge, 22 - 24 February 2023, we must now ask parents for a firm commitment should you wish your child to participate.

As discussed at the meeting, Carroty Wood is enclosed in 58 acres of mature woodland with plenty of natural habitat and wildlife for groups to enjoy, and a perfect location for the children to experience new adventures and explore the outdoors in a safe environment. The children will be taking part in instructor led activities and there is also the opportunity to swim in the indoor heated pool.

Residential courses organised by the school are optional but an invaluable part of the National Curriculum. Pupils benefit hugely from the experience, both educationally and socially, and I feel certain that the programme which is chosen for the children of St Faith's will prove to be both enjoyable and very worthwhile.

The cost of the trip will be approximately £225.00, depending on the number of children attending, and once accurate numbers are confirmed we will advise you of any change to this amount. This includes the residential stay at Carroty Wood, all activities, meals, and transport to and from the venue. As we have paid a holding deposit to secure this booking with Carroty Wood, we are now asking for a commitment if you wish your child to attend this residential trip.

The cost of this trip will be added to your Spring term invoice issued at the end of the Autumn term.
